Helse Møre og Romsdal HF is a health enterprise operating under Helse Midt-Norge RHF and is responsible for the specialist public health in Møre og Romsdal, the region in Western Norway. The enterprise consists of hospitals in Volda, Ålesund, Molde and Kristiansund as well as several other institutions in the same area. The enterprise has 6500 employees who provide a wide range of health services within somatic and mental health care. Our main goals are high-quality patient care, education of the staff, research and training of patients and relatives. Our vision is to play „in one team for your health“.

In 2018 we started to build a hospital which is going to cater for entire Nordmøre og Romsdal region. The hospital will be situated in Molde municipality and is expected to be completed in 2024.



The hospital caters for an area of approximately 115,000 inhabitants. The hospital has a section for gastro-surgery, urology, plastic surgery, orthopedics and a wide range of other specialties such as laryngology, ophthalmology, internal medicine, neurology, maternity/obstetrics, radiology and lab, anesthesia and intensive care. In addition, the hospital has emergency surgical and trauma section. The surgical section performs approximately 800 gastro-surgical procedures each year.

Molde a town and municipality in Møre og Romsdal region in Western Norway. It is the administrative center of Møre og Romsdal. Molde has a maritime,

temperate climate, with cool-to-warm summers, and relatively mild winters. The town is nicknamed *The Town of Roses*.

Molde is the 38th most populous municipality in Norway with a population of 26,822. Molde has its own airport and is situated in the near vicinity of Ålesund and Kristiansund. It has good road, train and flight connections with the rest of Norway and some other destinations in Europe. It has a rich cultural life, and is well known for annual jazz festivals. It provides all possible kinds of outdoor activities in spectacular natural setting. The famous **Trollstigen (Trolls' path)** and **the Atlantic Road** are just round the corner!



The Department of Obstetrics and Gynaecology has units in obstetrics and gynaecology at our hospitals in Kristiansund, Molde, Volda and Ålesund. We offer pregnancies, birth, and maternity care to mothers from our primary area. Pregnant women and mothers with various complications will receive follow-up at Ålesund Hospital. We have the diagnosis and treatment of all common gynaecological conditions.

For some patients, it may be relevant to be admitted to hospital for planned treatment or in need of emergency health care. At Ålesund Hospital, patients are admitted to the surgical ward. At the hospitals in Kristiansund, Molde and Volda, patients are admitted to the maternity wards or surgical

wards. A patient has the right to information about the illness, results of examinations and a plan for further treatment and follow-up. Surgical procedures are considered in consultation with the patient and possibly relatives. Gynaecological cancer conditions are treated in collaboration with St. Olav's Hospital and the Cancer Department at HMR.

Gynecological outpatient clinic Molde and Kristiansund

At the outpatient clinic, referred patients receive diagnosis, diagnosis and treatment of gynaecological conditions. Ultrasound examination in 17-20 weeks of pregnancy is an offer for all pregnant women after a referral from a GP or midwife. For pregnant women with risk conditions, follow-up during pregnancy at the outpatient clinic may be relevant.

Women who want a self-determined abortion can contact the outpatient clinic without a referral.

The tasks will be related to obstetrics, outpatient clinic and surgical activity. You will be part of several dedicated employees, a good work environment with a high professional standard where it works well in teams.

SALARY

- During the language training up to B2 level in Norway the doctor will work part time (80 %) until he/she has met the objectives of the additional training program. A full time salary for this period will be **NOK 819.200,-** per annum until the doctor passes the B2 exam.
- A full time basic gross salary including on-calls shall be approximately **NOK 1.500.000,-** per annum (**ca. 12.350 euro gross monthly**), provided that the doctor is working full-time, has achieved approval as a specialist in his/her field in Norway and is able to practice on his/her own.
